Annual General Meeting:

Harry Hunt called for nominations for the Executive Committee. Brett Lane from Hubertus Country Club nominated and there being no objections his nomination was accepted. There being no other nominations, the existing members of the Executive Committee agreed to retain their positions.

Harry Hunt read a proposed amendment to the Accord Constitution relating to the wearing of colours of specific motorcycle-related organisations (attached). Chris Donovan explained the proposed sign developed by the Executive Committee referred to in the proposed amendment. The amendment is to be voted on at the next meeting.

There being no further business the Annual General Meeting portion of the meeting was closed.

General Business:

Kee Sisouvath presented the Green Valley LAC report, and recommended regular ID checks for all venues during the upcoming warmer months as underage drinking has been a concern.

Harry Hunt thanked Sergeant Jillian Gibson for her representation of Liverpool LAC and her community service and dedication to the Accord during her time as Licensing Sergeant at Liverpool LAC.

Grant Haywood from The Mill Hotel presented to the Accord about the bomb scare at his venue in 2012 and the subsequent effect on the business. The venue has since had a no colours policy in place and have introduced the PatronScan system.

Michael Giannak from PatronScan presented to the Accord about the PatronScan system and its implementation at The Mill Hotel.

Harry Hunt thanked the presenters and encouraged vigilance among venues during the holiday season.

Proposed amendment to the Liverpool City Liquor Accord Constitution

Date: 24/11/2015

For the consideration of Liverpool City Liquor Accord members

It is proposed that the following amendment be added to the constitution subject to approval by vote at the next meeting of accord members:

47. A member of the association must not permit any person to enter the member's licenced premises, or to remain on the premises, if the person is wearing or carrying any clothing, jewellery or accessory displaying:

a. the name of any of the following motorcycle-related and similar organisations:

- i. Bandidos,
- ii. Black Uhlans,
- iii. Brothers for Life,
- iv. Coffin Cheaters,
- v. Comancheros,
- vi. Finks,
- vii. Fourth Reich,
- viii. Gladiators,
- ix. Gypsy Jokers,
- x. Hells Angels,
- xi. Highway 61,
- xii. Life and Death,
- xiii. Lone Wolf,
- xiv. Mobshitters,
- xv. Mongols,
- xvi. Muslim Brotherhood Movement,
- xvii. Nomads,
- xviii. Notorious,
- xix. Odins Warriors,
- xx. Outcasts,
- xxi. Outlaws,
- xxii. Phoenix,
- xxiii. Rebels,
- xxiv. Scorpions, or

b. the colours, club patch, insignia or logo of any such organisation, or

c. the "1%" or "1%er" symbol, or

d. any image, symbol, abbreviation, acronym or other form of writing that indicates membership of, or an association with, any of the organisations specified in paragraph (a).

Optional signage shall be made available to members to display at entrance points to the venue. Any such signage shall be approved by the association.



This venue does not permit patrons to display the name, colours, club patch, insignia or logo of any of the following organisations while on the premises:
